Can anyone do it?

There are no entry requirements for this qualification, though candidates will need to be employed in a suitable position, as it is assessed 'on-the-job'.

What does it cover and how will I learn?

The qualification covers a wide range of competencies at operative level and covers a wide range of roles within the waste, recycling, resource management, facilities and cleansing services. It is assessed 'on-the-job' and learning will take place naturally as part of the normal working environment and routine.

How will I be tested?

An assessor will visit your workplace to observe your work 'on-the-job'. You will compile a 'portfolio of evidence' which will demonstrate that you have the knowledge and competence necessary to meet the standard set in the qualification.

What next?

The qualification provides progression opportunities by utilising units that are common to other waste management QCF qualifications.
